

My grown up and I are going to Anna Shaw Children's Institute...


The building is big. It has a lot of windows and flowers.

I can look around the lobby and play with toys.






When my name is called, I will see a nurse. At Anna Shaw Children's Institute, there are no boo-boos or owies. We can have fun here.



The nurse needs my help with a few things.






Height and Weight

Measurement


The nurse needs to know how big my brain is. She will measure my head. It can be quick.
