



Visitation Guidelines for Hamilton Medical Center as of 7/10/20

As part of a statewide effort to limit the spread of COVID-19, Hamilton Medical Center has implemented a No Visitors Policy. As is being done at other hospitals, we will only allow visitors in certain extraordinary circumstances.

OUTPATIENT PROCEDURES

Patients having a surgical procedure at Hamilton Medical Center may have one support person with them. The support person must be age 18 or older and must be screened and wear a mask or face covering at all times while in the hospital. The support person must remain in the surgical waiting area or in his/her vehicle upon coordinating with surgical staff.

LABOR & DELIVERY

Mothers may have one support person (spouse, partner, doula, etc.) for the duration of delivery and postpartum care. The support person must wear a mask or face covering except when in the room alone with the mother and baby.
