



## **Visitation Guidelines for Hamilton Medical Center as of 2/17/22**

- **General Visitation Hours: 7:00AM – 7:30PM daily**
- **Non-COVID patients** may have 2 visitors per patient room permitted at a time from 7:00AM – 7:30PM.
- **1 support person may stay overnight** in the patient room from 7:30PM – 7:00AM.
- **COVID patients** may have only one designated visitor for every 24-hour period (cannot switch out during the day or night) until the patient is no longer under isolation precautions. See COVID patient visitor information for more details.

### **Expectations for All Visitors**

- Visitors who are known to be sick, or have a temperature of 100.4 or higher at screening will not be permitted to enter the hospital, even if they are the designated visitor for a patient who has COVID. This is without exception.
- No visitors under the age of 12 except in special, approved circumstances. Children under 18 must be under direct supervision of an adult guest at all times.
- On entrance, all visitors will have a temperature check and asked pertinent screening questions.
- Masks or face coverings must be worn appropriately at all times, covering the nose and mouth. This is without exception and will be strictly enforced.
- If visitors do not comply with visitation requirements, they will be escorted out and not permitted reentry for visitation.
- Patients with disabilities, as defined by ADA, are permitted a support person at all times.
