



Visitation Guidelines for Hamilton Medical Center as of 7/11/22

Inpatient Facility:

- Visitation Hours: 7am – 7:30pm
- **Masks are required AT ALL TIMES**
- 3 visitors welcomed at a time
- 1 visitor may stay overnight (MUST BE 18 OR OLDER) If visitors leave at times the front lobby doors are locked, they must exit through ED. (Signage will be at lobby doors instructing where to exit.)
- Patients positive for COVID may have one designated visitor per 24 hours until isolation is discontinued.
- Children under the age of 12 will not be permitted to visit the hospital.
- Main hospital waiting areas are currently closed.

Emergency Department

- **Masks are required AT ALL TIMES**
- 2 visitors permitted with patient
- If patient is confirmed or suspected of having COVID-19, 1 visitor will be permitted for the duration of the Emergency Department stay.
- Children under the age of 12 will not be permitted to visit the hospital.

Mother/Baby Unit, Labor & Delivery:

- Visitation Hours: 7am – 7:30pm
- **Masks are required AT ALL TIMES**
- 1 support person and 2 additional visitors at a time
- Support person may stay at all times
- Children under the age of 12 will not be permitted to visit the hospital.

NICU

- 2 visitors permitted at a time (Parents and Grandparents only)
- **Masks are required AT ALL TIMES**

VISITORS MUST NOT ENTER IF:

- You have a fever of 100.4 or feel like you may have a fever
- You have had COVID in the last 2 weeks
- You are waiting on COVID test results
- You know you have been exposed to COVID in the past 2 weeks
- Experiencing nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
